Mr. Sagar Pol highlighted the following points:

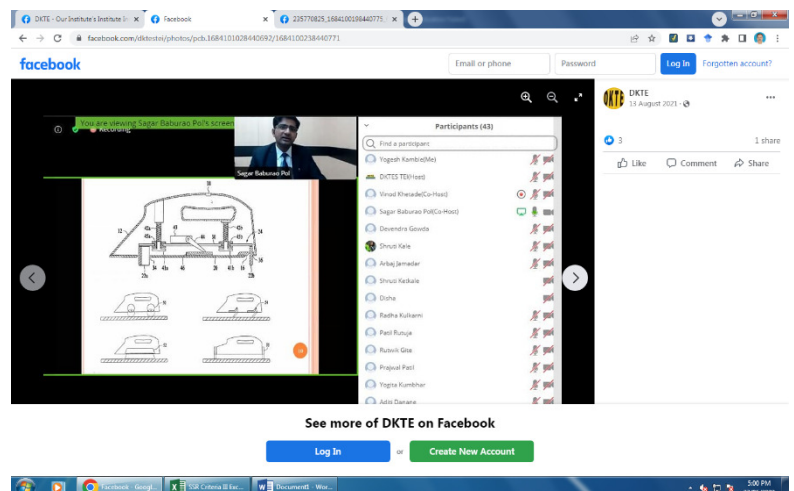
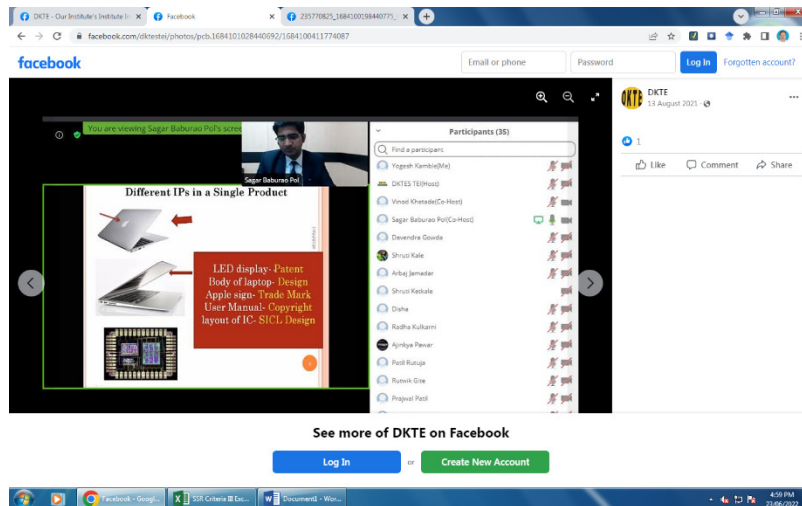
